TV and Radio use pitches, they are called commercials.



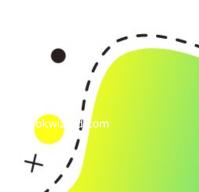


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Start up founders need a pitch to get an angel investor.

A pitch should answer

- Who
- What
- Where
- When
- And How

A pitch should make you want more!





Step #1 What is your book about?

Fiction – try to capture the plot.

Nonfiction – try to capture what the reader will learn.



Step #2 Context!



Readers want to know what sense of world or philosophical mindset they will be immersed in.





Step #3 Make it worth their time!

Add texture, details and rhythm. Let your voice show through.
